# HELLO SAILOR & DRAWN TOGETHER 30's sailors and drawings from the studio

Arts Project Australia launches its first two exhibitions for 2015: a solo exhibition by Paul Hodges *HELLO SAILOR* & a group exhibition *DRAWN TOGETHER*, both opening Saturday 7 February from 3-5pm in Northcote.

Taking a slight departure from his archetypal portraits inspired by people he observes in popular culture and the arts, Paul Hodges solo exhibition *Hello Sailor* launches a new collection of paintings that focus on sailors and seamen from the 1930's.

Gallery Manager Sim Luttin said, "Paul Hodges has been a regular studio artist at Arts Project Australia since 1998, and has been included in numerous group exhibitions and is held in private collections throughout Australia. This is Paul's first solo exhibition".

Coinciding with *HELLO SAILOR* is *DRAWN TOGETHER*, curated by Suzanne Brown and Elyss McCleary, which brings together a collection of artists from Arts Project Australia with a connection to drawing.

Drawing is a fundamental form of human expression: It has versatility, immediacy and directness and encompasses a diversity of approaches, styles and mediums. *Drawn Together* presents a broad scope of drawing made by artists at Arts Project Australia.

Curators Suzanne Brown and Elyss McCleary said, "For many artists, drawing their primary medium and is an important component of their practice. It is a way of seeing and investigating the world – and that may be with a pencil or a computer".

The exhibitions will be opened by Wilma Tabacco, Artist & Co-Director, Langford 120.
