Sometimes drawing can be dark and disturbed & Under Pressure

Two new exhibitions opening at Arts Project Australia

Opening Saturday 3 February are Arts Project Australia's first exhibitions of 2018; **Adrian Lazzaro**'s solo show **Sometimes drawing can be dark and disturbed** and **Under Pressure**, a group exhibition exploring the process of printmaking.

Wrestlers, vampires, erotica, clowns and imaginary figures; these are the images that infiltrate Adrian Lazzaro's thoughts and practice. Oscillating between chimera, desire and reality, Lazzaro works across drawing, painting, digital art and soft sculpture. By persistently pursuing darkness and disturbance in his work – both psychologically and physically – Lazzaro's imagery carries sinister interpretations with a quirky humour and wry outlook. Sometimes drawing can be dark and disturbed is Lazzaro's first solo show at Arts Project Australia.

Lazzaro has exhibited in group shows both nationally and internationally including Spring 1883, Sydney (2017); Turning the Page, Gallery 101, Ottawa, Canada (2014); and My Puppet, My Secret Self, The Substation, Newport.


Meanwhile *Under Pressure* is a group exhibition that will explore how the talents and skills of Arts Project printmakers are expressed and transformed through the literal and metaphorical 'pressure' of the printmaking process. The works of five established printmaking artists — Michael Camakaris, Bronwyn Hack, Chris O'Brien, Lisa Reid and Fiona Taylor — will be accompanied by artist books and a salon-style hang showcasing recent works by all Arts Project printmakers.

Curated by Yoshe Gillespie, *Under Pressure* will highlight the range of techniques and approaches to printmaking employed by Arts Project printmakers and provide a unique opportunity to view recent works by the artists.
